Embers International is excited to share this programmatic update with the Smith Family Foundation. The below are highlights of some of the indicators we are tracking to better understand program progress and intended outcomes for the survivors we support. We hope they encourage you!

R3G2 - RESTORATION, RENEWAL & REINTEGRATION FOR GENERATIONS

Embers International - in collaboration with local case manager partners and through the financial support from The Smith Family Foundation - has placed 3 family units (mothers and their children), who were previously trapped in a life of commercial sexual exploitation, on a path toward intergenerational freedom and flourishing.

The program includes outreach to a monthly average of 25 women in the red-light districts of Mumbai with various offerings (opportunity to learn and receive help) so that they may have hope to pursue a new life of freedom from commercial sexual exploitation.

WHAT DO OUTREACH ACTIVITIES LOOK LIKE?



HOLISTIC CARE

This may include counseling, social support, addressing acute medical needs, distribution of food and other basic needs.



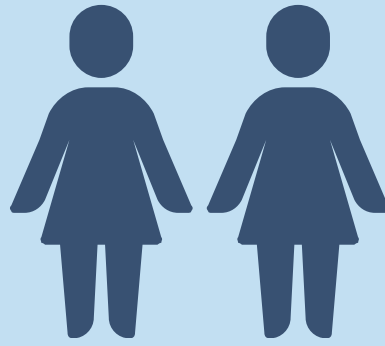
TIME AND PATIENCE

PHYSICAL SAFETY & HEALTH: RESTORATION

Regular living and safety assessment



Identify secure housing need



Sign lease agreement



Establish safety plans & review weekly for 6 mo- 1 yr



Basic needs: (furnishing, clothing, communications, transportation)



Physical health: identify medical/nutritional needs



Provide health care, check ups, medication



Provide nutritional support



Trauma-care: psychological assessment
