We examined nearly 1000 patients from the bateyes of Mata Palacio, Morquecho, Casa Colorada, Magua, Monte Coca, Consuelo, Hato Mayor, and Las Pajas.



Following our last day of clinic, a wonderful meal of authentic Dominican cuisine was prepared for us- consisting of goat, fish, chicken, rice & beans and yucca.



Each member was honored with a certificate of recognition for our hard work throughout the week and dedication to patient care. We even got to salsa with some of the locals!



And of course, we got a little down time as well to spend on the beach....



In addition, as a thank-you from the BRA, we enjoyed a day trip to the capital of the Dominican Republic, Santo Domingo.



We dispensed non-prescription sunglasses and artificial tears to nearly every patient as well as prescription glasses to those requiring refractive correction. These included single vision and/or bifocal spectacles for myopia, hyperopia, astigmatism, and presbyopia totaling nearly 2200 pairs of sunglasses and glasses dispensed for the week!

Even though you will not be walking alongside us at graduation this year, I'm sure I speak for our class as a whole when I say that you will always be considered one of the Class of 2008. With that said, let's go skydiving again!*
