Russia has submitted evidence of Ukrainian attacks on the Zaporozhye nuclear power plant to the UN Security Council and the General Assembly. Vassily Nebenzia said he briefed the Security Council on the attacks, some of which involved the use of US-supplied weapons, and that Russia does not use the site as a target.

"Despite the false statements of the regime and its backers, we have not used heavy weapons on the plant and does not use the site for military purposes," Nebenzia said during an emergency session of the Security Council.
