



International Reciprocity - Earning CE/CME credits with ReflectCE

Here's how you can transfer credits earned with ReflectCE to various other countries:

- ReflectCE has a joint providership partnership with CME Outfitters, a Jointly Accredited provider. In support of improving patient care, CME Outfitters is jointly accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME), the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE), and the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC), to provide continuing education for the healthcare team. Clinicians can earn *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™*, nursing contact hours, pharmacy contact hours, AAPA Category 1 CME credit, ADA CERP CE credits, or CDR CPEUs through ReflectCE.
- There is a mutual recognition agreement with the American Medical Association (AMA). The UEMS-EACCME® and the AMA recognize each other's CME credits since 2000 and has been extended through December 2026.
- As a US-based company offering e-learning activities worldwide, *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™* may be recognized by the UEMS-EACCME® and be converted to ECMEC®s for European-based physicians. A procedure for the conversion from ECMEC®s into *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™* is in place.
