

Arlington Community Learning Clinic

Program Information & Participation Guidelines

Hosted by MethodK Learning Design in partnership with Faith Lutheran Church

The Arlington Community Learning Clinic is a free drop-in educational support program designed to provide students with access to academic guidance, skill-building opportunities, and a welcoming learning environment throughout the summer.

The clinic supports students entering grades 4–12 and may provide assistance with mathematics, SAT preparation, STEM coursework, summer enrichment and building a summer learning/study plan, study skills, and academic questions.

How the Clinic Works

The Arlington Community Learning Clinic operates as a drop-in program.

Students may attend as often as they would like and may stay for a short period of time or for the full clinic session. Attendance is not required every week.

Students may bring:

- Current assignments
- Summer review materials
- SAT preparation questions
- STEM coursework questions
- Specific topics they would like help understanding

Students who are unsure where to begin may also receive guidance in identifying an appropriate starting point and may receive help building a summer study/learning plan.

Parent & Guardian Responsibilities

Parents and guardians remain responsible for:

- Student transportation to and from the clinic

- Communicating any important medical, accessibility, or emergency contact information
- Determining when their student will arrive and depart during clinic hours

The Arlington Community Learning Clinic is an educational support program and is not intended to serve as a childcare or custodial supervision program.

Student Expectations

Students are expected to:

- Treat others respectfully
- Contribute positively to the learning environment
- Follow facility guidelines and instructions
- Use clinic resources appropriately

MethodK Learning Design reserves the right to discontinue participation if a student's behavior repeatedly disrupts the learning environment or creates safety concerns.

Schedule Updates & Closures

Occasionally, clinic sessions may be adjusted, relocated, or canceled due to holidays, weather conditions, facility scheduling needs, or other circumstances.
