

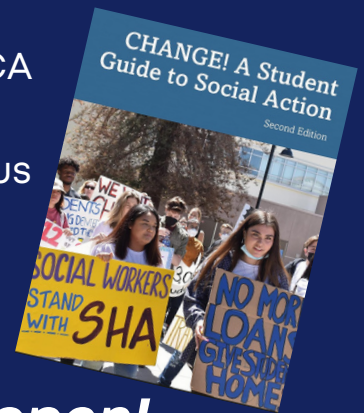
Teaching Social Action Indiana '27
