For this project, you will be working with a group to prepare a deliverable document regarding the data collected about older adults' experiences on campus (whether a flyer, brochure, PowerPoint, and so on – it is your choice!). It is you and your group's responsibility to think about how might be best to present findings (NOTE: you cannot present on absolutely everything, and that is okay. Pick and choose what you and your group want to focus on. This will likely differ from group to group). Should you make some charts or graphs in Excel? Or should you present the results in text? These types of decisions are entirely on you.

There will be four parts in this project: 1) an introduction 2) data description 3) results 4) conclusion/discussion. An introduction that goes over research on older adults on college campuses/why this is important should go in the beginning. You should cite at a minimum 3 studies that go over older adults on college campuses. For the data description, you will just need to copy and paste a few sentences that I will send you (you will not create this part). This will look the same for each group. For the results, you will need to take the information I give you and think about what might be the best way to present the data. This could be in a graph, it could be written, it could be in a word cloud. This is entirely up to you. This section should only present the data – do not include any interpretations in this section. The final part – the conclusion/discussion – is where you interpret the results. Questions you might answer include (but are not limited to) - what do these findings mean for older adults in the greater Montclair areas? What can the university do with these findings? What policies might be helpful?
