WHEREAS, Section 903.047, Florida Statutes was amended effective October 1, 2015, to provide additional specifications for a "no contact" with the victim order as a condition of pretrial release: and

WHEREAS, defendants may be released pretrial numerous ways, including but not limited to : released on his recognizance (ROR); released on bond before an advisory hearing; released on bond after an advisory hearing; and release on pretrial supervision with various conditions; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure that all defendants on pretrial release are provided with a "no contact" with the victim order, the sheriffs of the Twelfth Judicial Circuit must be able to provide said order to defendants;

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to the authority conferred by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, the "no contact" with the victim order shall apply as a condition of pretrial release to all applicable defendants and shall be provided to defendants by the sheriffs of the Twelfth Judicial circuit prior to their release:

1. As a condition of pretrial release, whether such release is by surety bail bond or recognizance bond or in some other form, all defendants in criminal cases must:
 - (a) Refrain from criminal activity of any kind.
 - (b) Refrain from any contact with the victim(s) in defendant's case(s). **This no contact order is effective immediately and enforceable for the duration of the pretrial release or until modified by the court.** "No contact" includes the following prohibited acts:
 - 1) Communicating orally or in any written form, either in person, telephonically, or in any other manner, either directly or indirectly through a third person with the victim or any other person named in the order. If the victim and the defendant have children in common, at the defendant's request, the court may designate an appropriate third person to contact the victim for the sole purpose of facilitating the defendant's contact with the children. **This does not prohibit an attorney for the defendant consistent with rules regulating The Florida Bar, from communicating with any person protected by the no contact order for lawful purposes.**
 - 2) Having physical or violent contact with the victim or other named person or his or her property.
 - 3) Being within 500 feet of the victim's or other named person's residence, even if the defendant and the victim or other named person share the residence.
 - 4) Being within 500 feet of the victim's or other named person's vehicle, place of employment, or a specified place frequented regularly by such person.
2. An invitation for contact from the victim does not affect this order and is not a defense to a violation of the no contact order. Contact with the victim, despite arising from an invitation from the victim, constitutes a violation of the no contact order.
3. Defendants shall receive a copy of this Administrative Order from the Sheriff's Office prior to defendant's release from custody on any applicable pretrial release.
4. The prohibitions contained herein are subject to modification by court order and may be supplemented by court order to include additional prohibitions.
5. This order is effective October 1, 2015.

Upon arrival I met with Ms. Megan Jordan and Mr. Elliot Carnahan who stated that they were babysitting Hayden Walcott for Ms. Sarah Walcott. Ms. Jordan and Mr. Carnahan stated that Mr. Michael Arnold called Ms. Jordan on the telephone and called her a "bitch". Mr. Carnahan and Ms. Jordan stated that Mr. Arnold and Ms. Walcott came to their residence.

Mr. Carnahan stated that he and Mr. Arnold got into an argument outside the apartment where Mr. Arnold pushed Mr. Carnahan. Mr. Carnahan stated that Ms. Walcott came outside and got between Mr. Arnold and himself. Mr. Carnahan stated that Ms. Walcott put her hand on his throat and pushed him also. Mr. Carnahan stated that he did not wish to press charges against Mr. Arnold or Ms. Walcott. Mr. Carnahan signed waivers for the battery on him. I did not observe any apparent injuries to Mr. Carnahan. Mr. Carnahan was issued a Victim's Right's Pamphlet.

Ms. Jordan stated that she came outside, while holding Hayden in her

as, when she heard the altercation and witnessed Ms. Walcott grab Mr. Carnahan on the throat. Ms. Jordan stated that Ms. Walcott told her to put Hayden down. Ms. Jordan stated she told Ms. Walcott to wait while she (Ms. Jordan) said goodbye to Hayden. Ms. Jordan stated that Ms. Walcott grabbed her by the arm and started twisting it in an attempt to throw her to the ground. Ms. Jordan stated that she was still holding Hayden at the time. Ms. Jordan stated that she grabbed Ms. Walcott's hair in an attempt to get Ms. Walcott away from her. Ms. Jordan stated this is when Mr. Carnahan broke them up. Ms. Jordan stated that Ms. Walcott took Hayden and forced him into her vehicle and left the area. Ms. Jordan stated several times that she did not wish to press charges against Ms. Walcott. Ms. Jordan stated that she was concerned for Hayden's safety due to Ms. Walcott and Mr. Arnold's drinking. Ms. Jordan stated that Ms. Walcott and Mr. Arnold are always drinking in front of Hayden. Ms. Jordan was issued a Victim's Right's Pamphlet.

Dep. Zangaza stated he heard the yelling outside his apartment and went outside to investigate. Dep. Zangaza stated that when he got outside he observed Hayden being verbally and physically forced into Ms. Walcott's vehicle by Ms. Walcott. Dep. Zangaza stated that both Ms. Walcott and Mr. Arnold appeared to have been drinking. Dep. Zangaza was issued a Witness Right's pamphlet.

I spoke with Ms. Walcott on the telephone and she stated that when they (Mr. Arnold and Ms. Walcott) arrived at Ms. Jordan's apartment to get Hayden, Mr. Carnahan and Mr. Arnold got into an argument because Mr. Arnold call Ms. Jordan a "bitch" telephone. Ms. Walcott stated there was no physical contact between herself and Mr. Carnahan. Ms. Walcott stated that when she told Ms. Jordan to put Hayden down, she (Ms. Jordan) grabbed her by the arm (Ms. Walcott) and was trying to fight her. Ms. Walcott stated that she started pushing back to defend herself against Ms. Jordan's attacks. Ms. Walcott stated that Hayden was fine and is sleeping in his bed.

Ms. Jordan, Mr. Carnahan and Dep. Zangaza all signed sworn witness statements.

I contacted Ms. Valerie (5433) via the CPS Hotline and started a report for the Child Abuse.

A Capias will be forwarded to the State Attorney's Office on Ms. Walcott. This report will be forwarded to the Detective's Division for further investigation on the Child Abuse.
