1. Always Confirm the Source

\square Type the web address yourself. Only trust official websites you enter manually.
☐ Check for HTTPS and the company's *exact* domain name—not something close
$\hfill\square$ Never click links in pop-ups, unexpected emails, or random text messages.
2. Pause Before Responding☐ If it feels urgent, it's probably a scam. Scammers pressure you to act fast.
$\hfill\square$ Never rush to send money, click, or reset a password without verifying first.
3. Protect Your Personal Info Never share any of the following with AI tools or unknown contacts:
□ Social Security number
☐ Bank account or credit card details
☐ Passwords or verification codes
Even realistic-sounding messages may be AI-generated phishing attempts.
4. Watch for Al-Enhanced Tricks ☐ Voice cloning: A 'relative' calls in distress? Hang up and call them directly.
\square Fake emails: Perfect spelling and logos don't prove it's real.
☐ Imitation websites: Check the IIRL carefully—one letter off can mean fraud

5. Verify Before You Trust
\square Call the company using the number on your card or their official website.
\square Confirm emergencies with another family member before sending money.
\square Ask a trusted friend before acting on anything unusual.
6. Golden Safety Habits ☐ Type, don't click—go directly to official sites.
\square Hang up on suspicious calls—and call back using a known number.
\square Confirm details before you act. If it feels off, stop and check.
□ Treat all urgency as a red flag.
If You Think You've Been Targeted ☐ Stop communication immediately.
\square Do not send money or share more information.
□ Contact your bank, credit card company, or local fraud hotline.
☐ Tell a trusted family member—scams thrive on secrecy.
