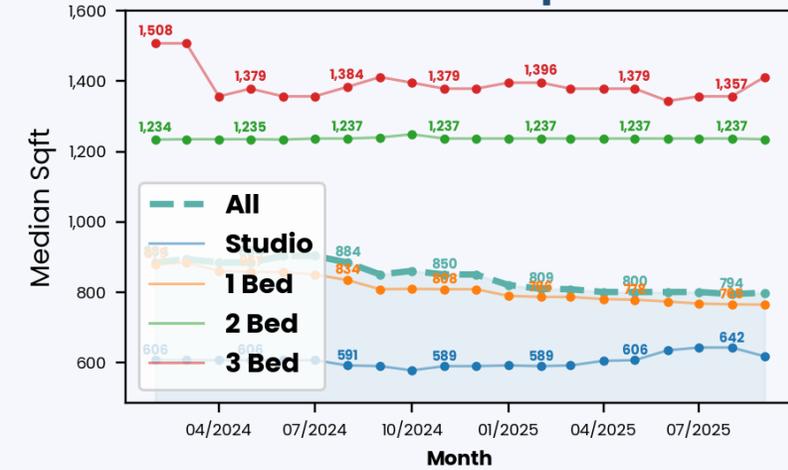

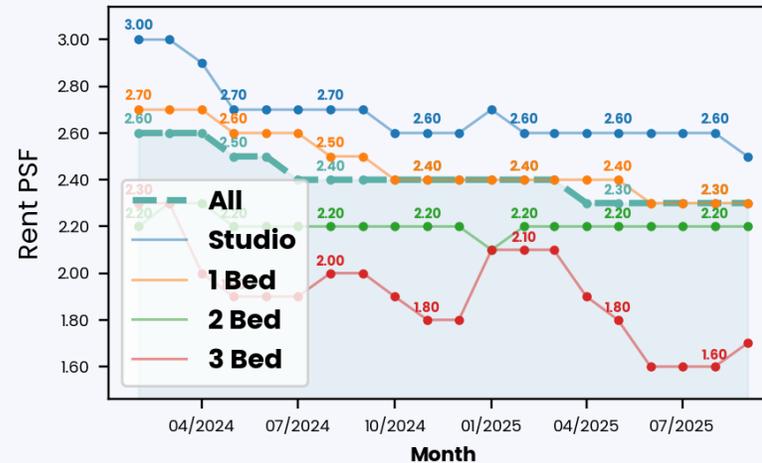

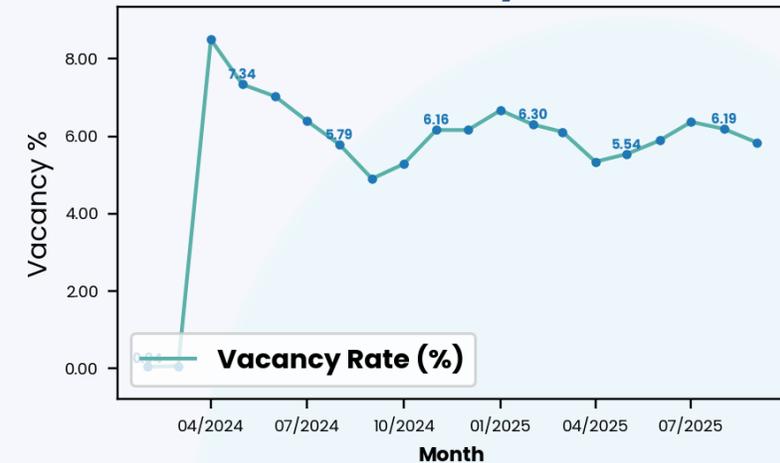
Median Sqft



Rent PSF

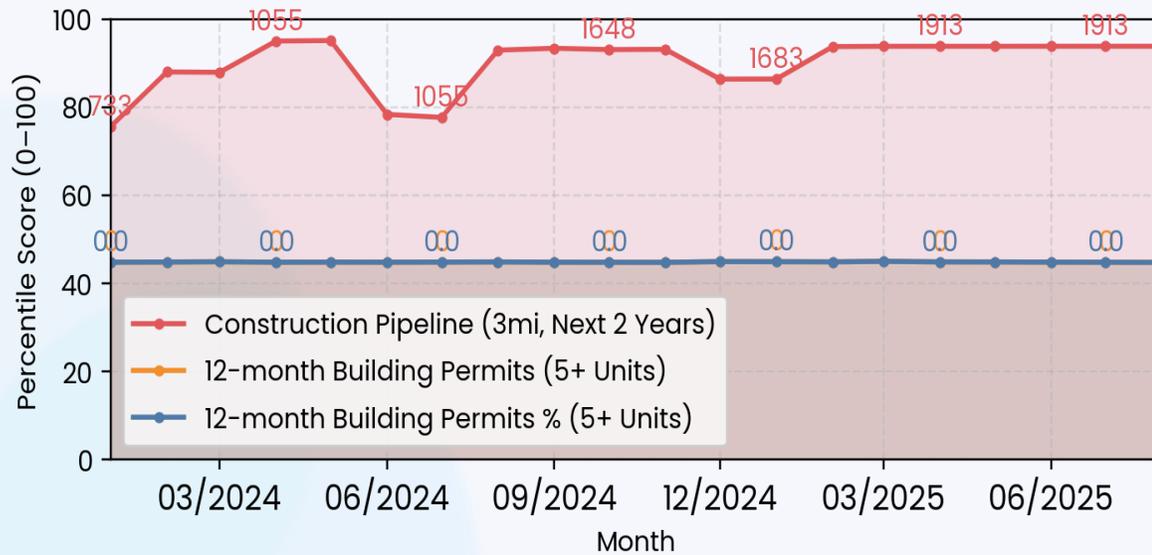
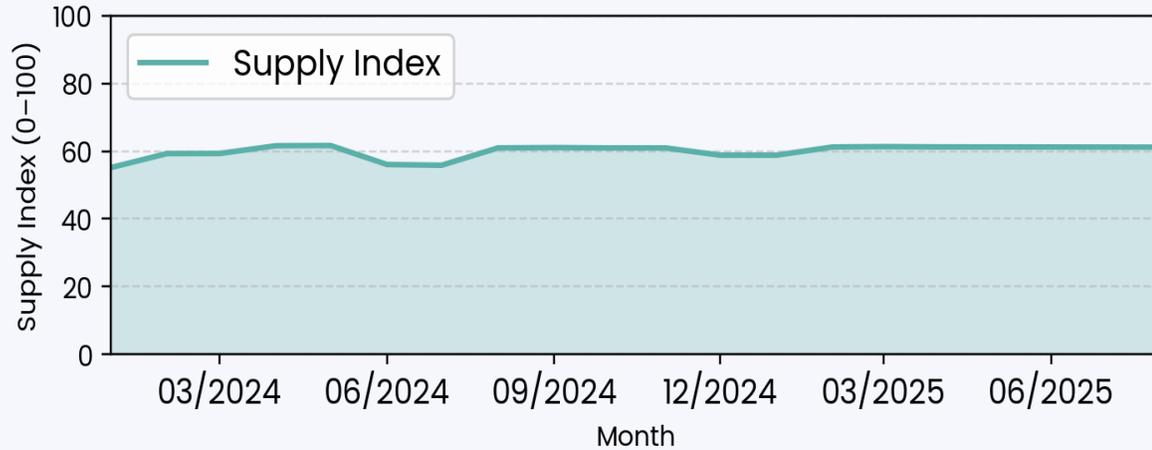


Vacancy %
