The event car parking will be The Craig y Nos country park just off the A4067 between

Ystradgynlais and Sennybridge.

There is a bus service from Brecon and Swansea that stops at Craig Y Nos Country Park, the

T6 TrawsCymru service.

Parking: There is a large car park with a compacted stone surface. This is a pay and display car park.

The country park car park may be busy as there are a number of events on, it is advisable

to arrive early.

Registration: The main toilet block and disabled access toilet is next to the visitor centre.

Start: Registration and download at Craig Y Nos Country Park Car Park

The route from the car park crosses the A4067 so please follow the taped route from the car park and walk along the A4067 to the crossing point and follow the marshall's

instructions.

The start is approx. 1.5km walk from the parking. It is up a steep narrow path with around

140m climb.

All Juniors under 16 must be accompanied by an adult to the start and from the finish as the route requires competitors to walk along a paved section of the A4067. Juniors must

wait at the finish to be accompanied back to the car park with a suitable adult.

About $\frac{2}{3}$ way up to the start you must cross a fence into a field and follow the tape to the start. If the weather is inclement then a tent will be provided for competitors to wait in.

Clothes and water can be left at the start/finish for collection after your run.
