Take the third exit, continuing on the A48 towards Tircoed / Pontarddulais for approx. 0.5km. Turn right towards Tircoed, keep right at the next roundabout, then after approx. 140m turn left into the village hall and car parking area. Registration (royal blue hi-top VW camper) and start/finish are all within the parking area		
Terrain:	Primarily a residential urban area with some woodland with mild undergrowth.
