EVENT DETAILS			
Location:	The Begwns hills ; south of Painscastle and north of Glasbury, near Hay-on-Wye. OS grid ref SO1617043630. What three words ///inflammehandfullsgloves.		
Travel directions:	A438 from Brecon to Hay on Wye. Turn left over river bridge at Glasbury. Turn first left after the bridge, through the village of Glasbury. Then first right up through Cwmbach, follow signs for Painscastle and our O signs until you reach the Begwns. Car parking off the road -good if dry, may be problematic if very wet. Registration, starts, first aid and download is near the road.		
Terrain:	Open hills with gorse, bracken, some marshy areas & ponds. There are numerous paths, not all marked on the map		
Map:	A4. 1:15,000 5m Contours on Green, blue & brown. A4 1:10,000 5m contours on Orange & Yellow & light green. Maps will be pre-marked but do not include a legend – separate map legends are
