Location:	OS Grid Ref SS748949, Post Code SA11 2TS				
	Parking at the end of Ynysymaerdy Road, Briton Ferry, Neath				
	The car park is small so expect to park on the street around the cemetery.				
Travel directions:	From The West: Cross the old Briton Ferry Bridge. Turn left at the roundabout onto Neath Rd (A474). Follow for approx half a mile and then turn right at traffic lights into Ynysmaerdy Road keeping to the right. Continue past the cemetery to the Forestry car park at the end of the road. From the East: Exit the M4 at Jct 42 and at the roundabout take the A48 towards Briton Ferry. At the following roundabout take Neath Road (A474) as above				
Terrain:	Steep sloping hill with a mix of ancient woodland and younger trees crisscrossed by a network of footpaths. The area features many small crags and platforms. At this time of the year the visibility/runnability in many parts of the forest drops substantially due to young Beech saplings filling with leaves just over head height! Courses have been planned to avoid these parts but be prepared to see an abundance of vegetation which is not necessarily mapped.
