

Points of interest in Bad Reichenhall include the Salt Museum, called the Alte Saline; the Glashuette, where glass can be observed as it is formed; music, chess and the spa garden can be enjoyed in the Kurgarten.

The modern salt processing plant can be observed in operation, as huge pumps suck the water from underground springs and begin the transformation to salt.

It is healthful to walk along the Gradierwerk, termed an open-air inhalatorium, built in 1869. Salty water trickles over a tall structure holding sticks and briars.

North of Bad Reichenhall is St. Zeno, a cloister built by Charlemagne.

Typical Bavarian dishes to whet the appetite include Weisswurst, the large white sausages, often devoured as mid-morning snacks, which prepare one for lunch.

Accommodations can be found in the Steigenberger-Hotel Axelmannstein, Kurhotel Luisebad; Panorama; Bayerischer Hof; Kurhotel Alpina; Tiroler Hof; Salzburger Hof; Deutsches Haus; and the Alpenhotel Fuchs on Thumsee.


