1. General.

Post Nuclear is a collection of presets for Native Instruments Kontour, Reaktor-based instrument. It comes in two formats: NKS presets (recommended) and Reaktor snapshot bank.

Sounds included in this library are aimed mainly at cinematic/trailer/film/game music. Post Nuclear is oriented towards dark, harsh, cold and sinister sounds but also offers everything else in between. Ideal for crafting your next horror track, dark sci-fi composition or post apocalyptic dark ambient music.

Included sound categories and number of presets:

- Atmospheric (36)
- FX (60)
- Hits (11)
- Keys (14)
- Pads (24)
- Rises and Builds (33)

2. Installation instructions.

NOTE: If you installed demo version previously, please remove it before installing full version to avoid duplicated presets when using Komplete Kontrol.

A. NKS Presets.

- Copy "Post Nuclear" folder from NKS Presets folder into:

MacOS: /HD/Users/Username/Documents/Native Instruments/User Content/Kontour (default location)

Windows: C:/Users/Username/My Documents/Native Instruments/User Content/Kontour (default location)

If you don't see this folder, you may create it manually or from within the Kontour ensemble loaded in Reaktor (right-click on "User" item in left pane in presets section and create any folder, this will create User Content folder and your custom folder inside it)

- Rescan content in Komplete Kontrol plugin/application

If you have different location, check it in your Reaktor preferences or Native Access preferences. In case of any problems, please refer to Reaktor documentation.

B. Reaktor snapshot bank.

- Open Reaktor and load Kontour Ensemble
- Enable “Edit Mode” (F1) at the top of the window next to magnifying glass icon
- In the left pane open presets/banks menu
- Right-click on “Embedded” menu item and select “New Bank”
- Select newly created bank, right-click and select “Load Bank”, locate Post Nuclear/Reaktor Banks folder and open file: Kontour Spektralisk - Post Nuclear A (repeat previous and this step for the second bank: Kontour Spektralisk - Post Nuclear B)
- To complete installation you need to save the Reaktor’s Kontour ensemble (it is recommended to use “Save as” to save it as a separate ensemble so that your factory ensemble stays intact)

In case of problems please refer to Reaktor documentation to see how to load snapshot banks into Reaktor ensembles.

3. User presets.

I recommend saving your own modified presets in location outside of Post Nuclear library folder so that you always have “factory” content at its original state.

4. Requirements.

The only requirement is that you have Native Instruments Reaktor and Kontour authorised with Native Access. For requirements of these instruments, please refer to Native Instruments website.
