

## Guess the Key Game Sheet

**Directions:** Read a statement and ask students to hold up the correct Key Card when you say "now." If students have the correct answer, they may move ahead three spaces on the gameboard. Students with the wrong answer will move back the same number of spaces. The correct answer is indicated at the end of each statement.

1. Andrea ironed a nice blouse and skirt for her interview. (2)
2. Aaron practiced talking about his experience working at Taco Bell. (3)
3. Jackie told the employer how she "would like to work for this company" at the end of the interview. (5)
4. John called the company where he was having an interview to ask about the product they make, the current sales record, and the name of the plant manager. (1)
5. Eddy called the employer after the interview to thank her for the interview. (6)
6. Janet practiced answering the question "What are your weaknesses" by telling the employer that she sometimes works too hard. (4)
7. At the end of the interview, Joyce told the employer that she felt she had the qualifications for the job and would like to be considered for the position. (5)
8. Alex explained how his experience working at the home improvement store would help him learn this job as a lumber salesman very quickly. (3)
9. Erica looked directly at the employer as she shook her hand, and said she was happy to meet her. (2)
10. When the employer asked Sandy to name her major strengths, she told him she was a hard worker, willing to learn, flexible and friendly. (4)
11. Rob went to the library to read about ABC Delivery in the Trucking and Freight Journal, before he went for his interview. (1)
12. Max called his interviewer the day after his interview to thank her. He also said he hoped to be considered for the job. (6)
13. Maria told her interviewer that her training in graphic arts would help her with the computer duties on this job. (3)
14. Josh answered the question, "describe yourself in one word," telling the interviewer that he was "flexible." (4)
15. Alison made sure she shook hands, smiled, and looked directly at the interviewer when she was introduced. (2)
16. Adam told the interviewer that he would like this job and felt he would be an asset to the company if he were chosen for the position. (5)
