You Are a Graduate! What's Next?

You have just graduated from high school. As you walk off of the stage, you are glad to have your diploma. You also feel a little scared. You are still unsure about your next step. Your parents want you to work full time to save money for a car. Your best friend just started a job at a factory making \$9.00 an hour, with no training or college. You, too, could start at the factory. Or you could go to a training program or a college and try for a better paying job later.

Activity: The Game of Life

- **STEP I:** To find out how much money you have received in gifts for your graduation, roll the dice to receive the amount listed below:
 - 1 = \$1002 = \$2003 = \$3004 = \$4005 = \$5006 = \$600



STEP 2: Add the amount you received in gifts to the \$200 you have saved. This is the total amount of money you will have for Step 3. Write the total here: \$_____. Your teacher will give you cash for this amount. Keep your cash safe!
