We continue to receive reports of crew being asked to take jumpseats or bunk seats during positioning or deadheading duties. We would like to remind all members that you are entitled to a confirmed passenger seat, and you should never be asked to give up this entitlement.

## **SCCS Eligibility & Numbers**

As part of our drive to support your career progression, we have secured updates to the SCCS 2025/26 Terms & Conditions through ongoing engagement and negotiations. These changes include a significant increase in positions for B787 pilots, a modest increase for both A320 & E190 pilots, and provisions for narrow-body to wide-body transitions. We wish all applicants good luck and congratulate successful candidates in advance!

## Standby & FRMC

**Pilots** 

There have been passionate discussions about Standby and its interpretation in the ANR. Through our engagements with CAAS and the Ministry of Transport, a Tripartite Fatigue Risk Management Committee has been established. In collaboration with Flight Operations, the Pilot Branch is leading a Working Group to review ANR rules surrounding standby. We will share more details as they become available.

## **Leave Bidding Exercise**

Many of you participated in our call for feedback to improve our leave bidding exercise, and we thank you for your input. The Pilot Branch has consolidated this feedback and shared it with the company. We are currently working with them to explore the practicality of implementing these suggestions in future leave bidding exercises.

#### **IPD for Instructors for Ground Sessions**

We raised the issue of Instructors being asked to conduct ground sessions on their off days. We can confirm that IPDs will not be payable for such sessions (as IPDs currently apply only to Flight Duties). However, instructors will be given the option to reschedule their fixed OFF days to accommodate these training sessions.

## **Increasing swaps**

We acknowledge members' requests to increase the flexibility and quota of duty and off day swaps. We have discussed this extensively with the company. As you may already know, the company is developing a Roster Marketplace. Although the launch is still some time away, we recognize that this initiative will address these flexibility concerns. Therefore, the Pilot Branch supports this initiative and will put our proposal on hold until after the launch.

## **Pilot Branch Representation**

**Pilots** 

Regarding membership growth across fleets, the Pilot Branch has implemented a seat re-balancing mechanism based on membership numbers from each of our 3 fleets. This system ensures proper and balanced representation in the branch by allocating seats according to membership strength. Without delving into technical details, recent leadership changes triggered a rebalancing when a delegate vacated their seat. The current seat distribution in the Pilot Branch is: 7 for B787, 6 for A320, and 2 for E190. This allocation will remain in place until the next rebalancing trigger occurs.
