

Deprescribing in Frailty – Quick Reference Guide & Checklist

Key Concepts

Deprescribing is an evidence-based, patient-centred process to reduce medication burden while maintaining therapeutic outcomes. It aims to optimise treatment according to patient goals, comorbidities, and level of frailty.

In Practice

Use this 5-step approach to apply deprescribing safely and collaboratively in practice:

Step	Focus	Actions / Checklist
1 Review	Clinical indication & necessity	<input type="checkbox"/> Assess indication, duplication, benefit-risk ratio, and adherence.
2 Identify	Potentially inappropriate medications (PIMs)	<input type="checkbox"/> Highlight drugs that may cause harm or no longer align with goals of care.
3 Plan	Deprescribing strategy	<input type="checkbox"/> Taper or stop medications where appropriate, prioritising high-risk agents.
4 Communicate	Team & patient engagement	<input type="checkbox"/> Discuss decisions with patient, GP, and care team; document rationale clearly.
5 Monitor	Follow-up & review	<input type="checkbox"/> Observe for withdrawal effects or symptom recurrence; adjust plan accordingly.

Clinical Reflection

“Would I start this medicine today if the patient were not already taking it?” — a key question to guide deprescribing decisions.
